

## Level 2 in Supporting Teaching and Learning

The Level 2 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning is designed to develop the critical skills and knowledge you need to work effectively within the education sector.



The Level 2 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning is designed for individuals interested in taking on a supporting role within schools. You will be working under the direction of the class teacher whose lesson planning and day-to-day direction set the framework within which the individual works. This qualification will give you new or an additional range of tools that will enhance your practice supporting learning in educational settings. Alongside improving your knowledge and skills, this qualification provides you with the essentials that any school requires; creating a pathway into a range of educational settings.

### Building Your Qualification

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The Qualifications and Credit Framework (QCF) allow you to develop skills and knowledge at a pace and level that suits your needs. Every unit and qualification in the new framework has a credit value.

Learners who have achieved any of the units in this qualification with Youthforce (or another accredited organisation) can transfer credits to the Level 2 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning. They must achieve no less than 30 credits.

### Progression

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Learners who achieve the Level 2 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning are eligible to progress to Level 3 Award/Certificate/Diploma. Learners can also seek opportunities within primary, special and secondary schools in both state and independent sectors, or seek a move into roles across the wider children's workforce such as child care, youth work or other related sectors.
